Mandatory Audit of Election and Submission of Audit results (if audit complete)

November 15, 2008 9:00 a.m.

Final Submission of Audit Results (if not previously submitted)

November 23, 2008 5:00 p.m.

In accordance with the Sunshine Law of Florida, these meetings are open to the public.

Note: Section 286.01105, Florida Statutes, states that if a person decides to appeal any decision by the board, agency, or commission with respects to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, he or she will need to record the proceedings, and that, for such purposes, her or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
