Open Mail Ballots



Volunteers make up three person teams who remove ballots from envelopes and secrecy sleeves, then flatten ballots to be tabulated. The process ensures the voter's right to a secret ballot.

Duplicate Mail Ballots



Volunteers work in pairs to duplicate Mail ballots which cannot be read by the optical scanners. The ballot is then presented to the Canvassing Board for approval.


